

LEENA ILMOLA-SHEPPARD

Dr. Leena Ilmola-Sheppard is a senior researcher at International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis (IIASA) as a researcher since 2008. She is working as a project manager in the Advanced Systems Analysis Program. She has worked as a project manager in the Game Changers and the Global Economy 2030 project, Seven Shocks Projects for Scotland, Finland and Korea. Her research theme is uncertainty and resilience of social systems; she is developing new modeling methods for foresight and tools for pragmatic decision making. The current projects are developing management systems for resilience.

Leena Ilmola-Sheppard is working as a Scientific Coordinator of the Global X-Network (GXN). The GXN consists of American, British, German, Austrian, Korean, Japanese, Finnish and French researchers that are dedicating their time for conducting a comprehensive research on extreme events, uncertainty and resilience. The aim of the network is to build a theory of surprise by 2018.

Leena Ilmola-Seheppard is working as an advisor for the Futures Committee of the Finnish Parliament (2013-) and for the Prime Minister's Office for the Finnish Government's Futures Review process (2012-2014).
