Introductory Dialog between Newly Accepted PhD-candidates and the Administration

Suggestion for the content of the conversation

Duties, benefits and regulations connected to the employment

- 1. Information about the office space and the use of the printers, computers, office supplies and alike. The most of the questions related to this topic are addressed in the *New at the Department of Mathematics*.
- 2. Information about the residence duty, deviations of residence duty and application for the research leave of absence (if teaching duties).
- 3. Inform about work hours, vacation, sick- and maternity/paternity leaves and alike.
- 4. For those with the teaching duties: talk about the work load and the tasks. Inform about teaching seminars organized by the Faculty.

Copyright policy/publishing and financing

- 1. Discuss the copyrights, inform about UiO-regulations connected to those.
- 2. Discuss other related issues to copyrights, especially if the candidate is employed and sponsored by another party.
- 3. Inform about the publishing practices at the Department.
- 4. Inform about the sources of financing and if some special relations exist depending on the source of financing.
- 5. Inform about the ways to apply for funding related to stays abroad, conferences and alike.



The aim and goals of a PhD and aftermath

- Inform the candidate about the career guidance initiatives at the faculty- and department-level.

Extras:

Discuss with the candidate if the following is important and why:

- 1. Taking part in the department/institution's common scientific work (seminars/meetings etc.).
- 2. Mingling with other PhD candidates and researchers at the department/institution.
- 3. Taking part in the common social activities in the department/institution (coffee breaks, discussions, parties etc.).
- 4. Inform about the social activities organized by and for PhD-candidates.
