

Application for study plan agreement

The study plan agreement is between the student, the supervisor(s) and the program council, and details the rights and obligations in connection with the plan for the master's degree programme. The agreement consists of this form, alongside other potentially necessary attachments.

The form must be filled and signed after the admission to the master's degree programme. The plan is filled out by the student in collaboration with the supervisor(s), and must be submitted to the program council by the program coordinator for approval by 1 December of the first semester.

4. Time schedule/progress plan

Full curriculum (all courses and work on thesis) for the master must be included here. The master's degree programme consists of 120 ECTS total, and it will therefore be either 60 ECTS thesis + 60 ECTS courses, or 30 ECTS thesis + 90 ECTS courses. A full time study consist of 30 ECTS per semester. Any deviation from this or part time studies must be approved by the programme council. Master courses taken before admission (transferred credits) must also be included.
