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CHANGES

Only very minor changes were implemented as compared to the course taught in 2017.

ATTENDANCE / VIDEOCONFERENCING

The course was well attended, with typically 10-14 students in the audience. There was no interest from other students in Norway and the lecture was not video streamed.

LEARNING MATERIALS

The students received copies of the lecture slides (312 pages; hardcopy and pdf) and exercise slides (165 pages; hardcopy and pdf). Electronic copies of the slides, movies and animations were posted on Fronter. An electronic copy of a supportive textbook was made available on Fronter.

ORAL EXAMINATION

The KJM5240 examination list included 16 candidates: 1 candidate received an “A”; 5 candidates received a “B”; 1 candidate received a “C”; 3 candidates received a “D”; 1 candidate received an “E”; 5 students did not show up to the exam. The KJM9240 examination list included 3 candidates: all 3 candidates passed the exam. One of the censors invited the students to assess their own performance after the exam. I think this a very valuable exercise for improving self-assessment skills of the students and raise awareness about weaknesses. I will pursue this practice in future exams.

FEEDBACK

There was a strong informal interaction with most students of this class (including person-to-person discussions if there was a need for changes or improvements). I did not consider it necessary to conduct a formal feedback session.
